His focus on improving individual performances and teamwork is now reflected in the team's results.

At 31 years of age he is married with one child, Charlotte and has lived in the Precinct for 7 years enjoying the convenience of the shops and parklands.

Nathan appreciated his 11 years with the Crows, which expanded his horizons and presented him with new opportunities.

Other than coaching, he is involved with **Diabetes SA as an "ambassador"** with his emphasis on **Juvenile diabetes** and early detection.

Being a diabetic himself, his involvement with Diabetes SA began not long after he assisted in the founding of the **Crows Foundation - a supporter of Diabetes SA.**

Nathan not only plays the role of mentor to the 150 or so young footballers at Norwood, he is also active in the mentoring program run by the **YMCA.**

This program offers support and guidance to children of single parent families.

The YMCA located in the Precinct is currently fund raising to meet the needs of 60 children in the program.

New Car Rental Pods

One of the effects of the global financial crisis has been a re-evaluation of transport use, with a resultant increase in patronage of **public transport** and the development of **car share schemes**.

Commercial car share has been 'picked up' by city dwellers as a viable cost-effective alternative to owning a second car!

The GoGet company has extended its service to Adelaide and with the help of **Adelaide City Council** has now set up 2 car rental pods – One at 101 Sturt St and the second at **Gilles St (corner of Vincent Place), near Hutt St.**

Cars can be booked online or via the phone in hourly 'blocks' of time, a special smart card opens the car, an onboard computer records time and kilometres, until returned to its pod. Payment is on a monthly basis (for time/kms) without costs of registration, insurance, petrol and maintenance to worry about.
